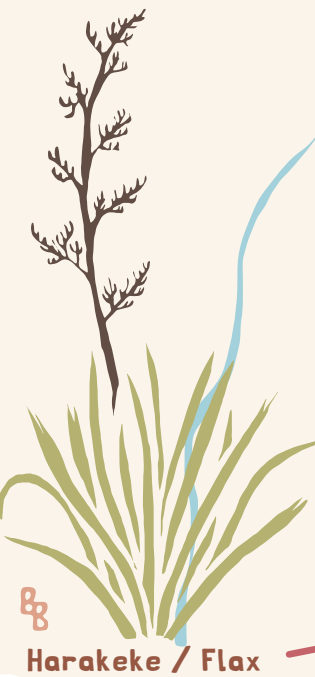


# Map of the Ōhaeawai Battle Site, 1845
